- brief research reports, teacher inquiries, and commentaries (2,000–4,000 words)
- full research articles (up to 8,000 words)

Word limits are inclusive of an abstract (150 words max), tables, figures, endnotes, and reference list.

Please use APA approved font types, (e.g. 12-point Times Roman typeface), double-spaced, 1-inch margins, and APA 7<sup>th</sup> Edition style.

## Review and Publication Timeline

All submissions will be peer-reviewed.

August 30 <sup>th</sup>	Anticipated publication date
