- brief research reports, teacher inquiries, and commentaries (2,000–6,000 words)
- full research articles (up to 8,000 words)

Word limits are inclusive of an abstract (150 words max), tables, figures, endnotes, and reference list.

### Formatting

Please use APA-approved font types, (e.g., 12-point Times Roman typeface), double-spaced, 1-inch margins, and APA 7<sup>th</sup> Edition style. **When you submit, please indicate in the COMMENTS box of the portal that your submission is for the 2025 Conference Special Issue.**

### Review and Publication Timeline

All submissions will be peer-reviewed.
